

God is literally bringing the nations to Orlando which makes it a strategic location for multicultural ministry.








CREATIVE VILLAGE

Builds on the success of Orlando's digital media industry by transforming the former site of the Amway Arena in downtown Orlando into a 68-acre mixed-use, transitoriented, urban infill neighborhood. This area will be home to leading higher-ed providers, high-tech, digital media, and creative companies, leading to a diverse mix of students, employees, and residents. Creative Village fosters a "live, work, learn, and play" lifestyle in the heart of downtown Orlando while bringing exciting opportunities to the Parramore area.

PARRAMORE

The neighborhood was established in the 1880s by Orlando's then mayor, James B. Parramore, as a place to "house the Blacks employed in the households of white Orlandoans." And for 60 years, it grew into a thriving Black community with 18k residents and streets lined with vibrant schools, theaters, local shops, familyowned restaurants, and hotels. But in the 1950s and 1960s, amidst civil unrest at the end of the Jim Crow era, new construction cut Parramore off from the rest of the area and the community suffered greatly.




Heaven's cultural value of redemptive vision. We view everyone and everything through the lens of what Christ wants to accomplish in and through them.

Prepare and equip students to take heaven's cultural values into their respective creative industries while raising up student leaders to reach their peers. Additionally, build relationships with faculty.

Show support for local businesses that serve our immediate community through personalized gifts and cards thanking them for serving and by flooding them with business.

newcreation school of theology

Theologically develop a diverse group of next generation leaders through a multicultural lens. Robust curriculum from diverse teachers. Diversity of academic resources.

newschool support

Connect with school leadership and support them in managing and leading successful classrooms. Champion teachers and their goals while contributing resources to meet needs of classroom.
